Agenda Items

- 1. Amendment to Sec. 8-1403, "PLUMBING LICENSE," of the Moline Code of Ordinances.** Amy Keys, Deputy City Attorney, stated that Section 8-1403, "PLUMBING LICENSE," of the Code currently provides that individuals applying for a plumbing permit to conduct work within the City must be a licensed plumber and must register with the City and pay a \$50 administrative filing fee. Pursuant to recent amendments to the Illinois Plumbing License Law, 225 ILCS 320/42, such licensing requirements must be regulated by the State of Illinois. Amending Sec. 8-1403 will bring the Code into compliance with the State statute regarding the licensure and registration of plumbers. A motion was made by Alderman Parker to approve. Seconded by Alderman Liddell. Motion passed unanimously.
