MOLINE CITY COUNCIL MEETING

City Hall, 619 16th Street
Tuesday, April 9, 2019

Council Meeting: The City Council meeting came to order at 6:56 p.m. The Council met in regular session in the Council Chambers at City Hall.

Pledge: The Council and audience recited the Pledge of Allegiance.

Invocation: Alderman Turner gave an Invocation.

Roll Call: Roll call was taken with Mayor Acri, Aldermen Williams, Parker, Wendt, Potter, Turner, Schoonmaker, Waldron and Berg present. Absent: none.

Items on Consent:

Approval of Minutes & Appointments

Committee-of-the-Whole and Council meeting minutes of April 2, 2019, and appointments made during Committee-of-the-Whole on April 9, 2019.

Second Reading Ordinances

1. Council Bill/General Ordinance 3010-2019

An Ordinance amending Chapter 8, "BUILDINGS AND OTHER CONSTRUCTION AND BUILDING SERVICES," of the Moline Code of Ordinances, to revise the annual contractor license and registration dates, by amending Section 8-1400, "GENERAL CONTRACTOR LICENSE," by repealing subsection (c) in its entirety and enacting in lieu thereof one new subsection (c) relating to the same subject matter; Section 8-1401, "ELECTRICAL CONTRACTOR LICENSE AND REGISTRATION," by repealing subsections (b)(5) and (8) in their entirety and enacting in lieu thereof new subsections (b)(5) and (8) relating to the same subject matter; Section 8-1402, "MECHANICAL CONTRACTOR LICENSE," by repealing subsections (e) and (i) in their entirety and enacting in lieu thereof new subsections (e) and (i) relating to the same subject matter; and Section 8-1405, "SEWER SERVICE AND MAINTENANCE BUSINESS LICENSE," by repealing subsection (d) in its entirety and enacting in lieu thereof one new subsection (d) relating to the same subject matter.

2. Council Bill/General Ordinance 3011-2019

An Ordinance amending Chapter 31, "TAXATION," of the Moline Code of Ordinances, Article I, "HOTEL-MOTEL TAXES," by repealing said article in its entirety and enacting in lieu thereof one new Article I, "HOTEL AND VACATION RENTAL TAXES," relating to the same subject matter.

Resolutions

3. Council Bill/Resolution 1038-2019~ this item was moved to the Non-Consent Agenda.

4. Council Bill/Resolution 1039-2019

A Resolution authorizing the ceding of 2019 Home Rule Volume Cap.

Omnibus Vote: Alderman Parker, seconded by Alderman Berg, moved to approve, by omnibus vote, these items. Motion carried on roll call with the following vote: ayes: Aldermen Williams, Parker, Wendt, Potter, Turner, Schoonmaker, Waldron and Berg; nays: none.

Items Not on Consent:**Resolutions****3. Council Bill/Resolution 1038-2019**

A Resolution to employ the services of Lisa A. Kotter as City Administrator of the City of Moline, and authorizing the Mayor and City Clerk to execute a Letter of Agreement between the City of Moline and Lisa A. Kotter.

Approved: Alderman Parker, seconded by Alderman Berg, moved to approve Council Bill 1038-2019. Motion carried on roll call with the following vote: ayes: Aldermen Williams, Parker, Wendt, Potter, Turner, Schoonmaker, Waldron and Berg; nays: none.

5. Council Bill/Resolution 1040-2019

A Resolution authorizing the Mayor and City Clerk to execute a Road Salt Purchase Agreement for the 2019-2020 Season with the City of Davenport.

Approved: Alderman Wendt, seconded by Alderman Parker, moved to amend and remove the initial 1,000-ton salt purchase, purchasing only the supplemental salt order. Municipal Services General Manager Rodd Schick supported the motion. Motion passed unanimously. Council Bill 1040-2019, as amended, carried on roll call with the following vote: ayes: Aldermen Williams, Parker, Wendt, Potter, Turner, Schoonmaker, Waldron and Berg; nays: none.

First Reading Ordinances**6. Council Bill/General Ordinance 3012-2019**

An Ordinance amending Chapter 20, "MOTOR VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC," of the Moline Code of Ordinances, Appendix 18 thereof, "TWO-HOUR PARKING RESTRICTIONS IN NONMETERED ZONES," by including Thirty-second Street, on the east side from Avenue of the Cities north to alley.

7. Council Bill/General Ordinance 3013-2019

An Ordinance amending Chapter 20, "MOTOR VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC," of the Moline Code of Ordinances, Appendix 10 thereof, "PARKING PROHIBITED AT ANY TIME," by including Twelfth Street, on both sides, from Fourteenth Avenue, north a distance of 25 feet.

Council, Staff and Citizen Comments:

Alderman Potter referred to the Avenue of the Cities Study and expressed concern that there is a lack of sidewalks, specifically on the south side of the Avenue from 27th to 34th Street. Alderman Potter asked staff to consider how including this area in sidewalk work this season might help those businesses.

Alderman Potter indicated that there is still a lot of contamination in the waste stream and recommended greater recycling communication and education to the public. Alderman Berg suggested including this demonstration at Public Works' Touch-a-Truck in May.

Alderman Schoonmaker acknowledged Interim City Administrator J.D. Schulte and staff for coming together with a unified voice and solution during a recent conflict negotiation.

Parks Recreation Director Lori Wilson shared that the annual Easter Egg Hunt will be this Saturday beginning at 9:45 a.m. for ages two and under, and 10:00 for those over two years of age.

Executive Session:

Alderman Berg, seconded by Alderman Wendt, moved for Executive Session, for the purpose of discussion of Property Acquisition-5 ILCS 120/2 (C) (5). Motion carried on roll call with the following vote: Ayes: Aldermen Williams, Parker, Wendt, Turner, Schoonmaker, Waldron and Berg; nays: Alderman Potter.

City Council convened in Executive Session at 7:15 p.m.


Alderman Berg moved to adjourn Executive Session, seconded by Alderman Wendt. Motion passed unanimously.
