**Council Meeting:** The City Council meeting came to order at 6:10 p.m. The Council met in regular session in the Council Chambers at City Hall.

**Pledge:** The Council and audience recited the Pledge of Allegiance.

**Invocation:** Alderman Schoonmaker gave an Invocation.

**Roll Call:** Roll call was taken with Mayor Acri, Aldermen Williams, Parker, Wendt, Turner, Schoonmaker, Waldron and Berg present. Absent: Alderman Potter

### **Second Reading Ordinances**

#### **1. Council Bill/General Ordinance 3012-2019**

An Ordinance amending Chapter 20, "MOTOR VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC," of the Moline Code of Ordinances, Appendix 18 thereof, "TWO-HOUR PARKING RESTRICTIONS IN NONMETERED ZONES," by including Thirty-second Street, on the east side from Avenue of the Cities north to the alley.

#### **2. Council Bill/General Ordinance 3013-2019**

An Ordinance amending Chapter 20, "MOTOR VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC," of the Moline Code of Ordinances, Appendix 10 thereof, "PARKING PROHIBITED AT ANY TIME," by including Twelfth Street, on both sides, from Fourteenth Avenue, north a distance of 25 feet.

A Resolution confirming the appointment of Interim Finance Director and authorizing said Interim Finance Director to execute all duties of the Finance Director of the City of Moline.

A Resolution amending Budget Resolution #1155-2018 by authorizing changes to various line items in the budget for FY 2019.

**8. Council Bill/Resolution 1046-2019**

A Resolution authorizing Information Technology staff to renew the software support and maintenance package with Lucity, Inc.

**9. Council Bill/Resolution 1047-2019**

A Resolution supporting the intent and effort of the Q2030 Interstate 74 Gateway Corridor Workgroup to create a unified and vibrant sense of place along the I-74 corridor.

**10. Council Bill/Resolution 1048-2019**

A Resolution authorizing the purchase of a 2019 John Deere 444KXT loader from Martin Equipment for the amount of \$154,225.00.

**11. Council Bill/Resolution 1049-2019**

A Resolution authorizing the purchase of three (3) John Deere 1570 TerrainCut Commercial Front Mowers with 72-inch cutting decks from Holland and Sons, Inc. for the amount of \$82,711.96.

**12. Council Bill/Resolution 1050-2019**

A Resolution authorizing the Mayor and City Clerk to execute an agreement with the Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD), to accept funding, and execute all necessary assurances and certifications to the Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD), including an Assistance Award Form, for program years 2019-2022 for the Lead Based Paint Hazard Reduction (and Healthy Homes Supplemental) Grant funds, awarded to the City of Moline, in the amount of \$2,400,000.

**Omnibus Vote:** Alderman Turner, seconded by Alderman Parker, moved to approve and adopt, by omnibus vote, these items. Motion carried on roll call with the following vote: ayes: Aldermen Williams, Parker, Wendt, Turner, Schoonmaker, Waldron and Berg; nays: none.

**First Reading Ordinances**

**13. Council Bill/Special Ordinance 4010-2019**

A Special Ordinance authorizing the City of Moline to allow Walsh Construction to vary from the requirements of Chapter 21, "NUISANCES IN GENERAL," of the Moline Code of Ordinances, Section 21-1100(18), to allow I-74 night construction work to proceed and authorizing the Public Works Director to unilaterally revoke the variance, if necessary.


**Council, Staff and Citizen Comments:**
