## MOLINE CITY COUNCIL MEETING

**Council Meeting:** The City Council meeting came to order at 8:52 p.m. The Council met in regular session in the Council Chambers at City Hall.

**Pledge:** The Council and audience recited the Pledge of Allegiance.

**Invocation:** Alderman Wendt gave an Invocation.

**Roll Call:** Roll call was taken with Mayor Acri, Aldermen Williams, Parker, Wendt, Potter, Moyer, Waldron and Berg present. Absent: Alderman Schoonmaker.

**Second Reading Ordinances**

**1. Council Bill/General Ordinance 3027-2019**

**An Ordinance enlarging the corporate limits of the City of Moline by annexing thereto a certain parcel of land in Rock Island County, Illinois, more particularly described as 3807 15<sup>th</sup> Street B.**

**Omnibus Vote:** Alderman Parker, seconded by Alderman Berg, moved to approve and adopt, by omnibus vote, these items. Motion carried on roll call with the following vote: ayes: Aldermen Williams, Parker, Wendt, Potter, Moyer, Waldron and Berg; nays: none.

**Council, Staff and Citizen Comments:**

Alderman Parker announced that Augustana men's basketball season opens on Saturday.

Alderman Berg congratulated Interim City Administrator J.D. Schulte and staff on budget preparation.

Alderman Wendt congratulated Alderman Berg on her appointment by Governor Pritzker to the State Housing Authority Board.

Interim City Administrator J.D. Schulte reminded that the November Council meetings are budget work sessions, but that staff will also bring a couple of time-sensitive Agenda items.

Community Development Program Manager K.J. Whitley explained that three focus group sessions will take place next week for the Quad Cities Housing Study. There will be two electronic surveys offered, one for landlords and one for tenants. Alderman Berg asked that staff boost social media posts about the events.

Mayor Acri wished Parks Recreation Director Lori Wilson well in her retirement.

On motion of Alderman Potter, seconded by Alderman Berg, Council adjourned at 9:00 p.m.
