**EXPLANATION:** Chapter 29 of the Moline Code of Ordinances requires that all land must be developed in accordance with the requirements of the Code, including the improvement of streets to City standards. 11<sup>th</sup> Avenue Place east of 34<sup>th</sup> Street is a dead end, unimproved street as narrow as ten feet in parts with deep ditches running along each side that would be extremely costly to improve and that serves a total of five

properties. Two of the five properties accessed by 11<sup>th</sup> Avenue Place are vacant lots, and the owners of these lots have requested that they be able to build on these lots without undertaking the cost of improving the road. This Council seeks to encourage the development of quality housing in the City and recognizes the uniqueness of the situation and topography of 11<sup>th</sup> Avenue Place and the burden of requiring the road to be improved for the development of two properties. The fire and safety regulations of the City allow for proper fire protection without an access road as long as the building is equipped with an approved automatic sprinkler system, and there is a fire hydrant located within 600 feet of the building.

WHEREAS, Chapter 29 of the Moline Code of Ordinances requires that all land must be developed in accordance with the requirements of the Code, including the improvement of streets to City standards; and

WHEREAS, 11<sup>th</sup> Avenue Place east of 34<sup>th</sup> Street is a dead end, unimproved street as narrow as ten feet in parts with deep ditches running along each side that would be extremely costly to improve and that serves a total of five properties; and

WHEREAS, two of the five properties accessed by 11<sup>th</sup> Avenue Place are vacant lots, and the owners of these lots have requested that they be able to build on these lots without undertaking the cost of improving the road; and

WHEREAS, this Council seeks to encourage the development of quality housing in the City and recognizes the uniqueness of the situation and topography of 11<sup>th</sup> Avenue Place and the burden of requiring the road to be improved for the development of two properties; and

WHEREAS, the fire and safety regulations of the City allow for proper fire protection without a standard width access road as long as the building is equipped with an approved automatic sprinkler system, and there is a fire hydrant located within 600 feet of the building.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MOLINE, ILLINOIS, as follows:

<u>Section 1</u> – That the City Council of the City of Moline, Illinois, hereby grants a variance to Chapter 29 of the Moline Code of Ordinances for the development of the properties located at 3705 and 3809 11<sup>th</sup> Avenue Place, parcel numbers 07-7990 and 07-6746-1, so that the road does not need to be improved to City standards as long as all buildings are equipped with approved automatic sprinkler systems and are located within 600 feet of a fire hydrant.

- <u>Section 2</u> That this ordinance shall be a temporary variance from any other ordinance with which it may conflict and shall not constitute a repeal of any such ordinance.
- <u>Section 3</u> -- That this ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after passage, approval, and, if required by law, publication in the manner provided for by law.
