## MOLINE CITY COUNCIL MEETING

City Hall, 619 16<sup>th</sup> Street  
Tuesday, April 21, 2020

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**Council Meeting:** The City Council meeting came to order at 8:00 p.m. The Council met in regular session in the Council Chambers at City Hall.

**Pledge:** The Council and audience recited the Pledge of Allegiance.

**Invocation:** There was no Invocation.

**Roll Call:** Roll call was taken with Mayor Acri, Aldermen Williams, Parker, Wendt, Potter, Moyer, Schoonmaker, Waldron and Berg present. Absent: None.

### **Items on Consent:**

#### **Approval of Minutes**

Committee-of-the-Whole and Council meeting minutes of April 14, 2020, and appointments made at Committee-of-the-Whole on April 21, 2020.

### **Second Reading Ordinances**

#### **1. Council Bill/General Ordinance 3012-2020**

An Ordinance amending Chapter 22, "OFFENSES-MISCELLANEOUS," of the Moline Code of Ordinances, Article I, by enacting one new Division 7 entitled "Registration of Certain Offenders."

#### **2. Council Bill/Special Ordinance 4006-2020**

A Special Ordinance granting a temporary modification to Section 28-3200(a) and Section 35-4218 of the Moline Code of Ordinances to permanently waive the installation of sidewalks for property located along 36<sup>th</sup> Avenue Court, pursuant to an application submitted by Haversian Canal Systems, LLP (ORA Orthopedics), 510 Valley View Drive, Moline.

### **Resolutions**

#### **3. Council Bill/Resolution 1053-2020**

A Resolution authorizing the Mayor and City Clerk to execute and attest to an agreement between the City of Moline and Quad City Towing, Inc. to provide towing services for the City of Moline for an initial three-year term.

#### **4. Council Bill/Resolution 1054-2020**

A Resolution authorizing the purchase of 3,000 tons of road salt through the Illinois Department of Central Management Services (CMS) for the City of Moline's 2020-2021 winter season.

Mayor Acri requested validation of a motion within the April 14, 2020 Committee-of-the-Whole Minutes, but did not have that reference at this time. Alderman Potter, seconded by Alderman Moyer, moved to amend and exclude the April 14, 2020 Committee-of-the-Whole Minutes. Motion passed on roll call with the following vote: ayes: Aldermen Williams, Parker, Wendt, Potter, Moyer, Schoonmaker, Waldron and Berg; nays: none. The amended motion passed on roll call with the following vote: ayes: Aldermen Williams, Parker, Wendt, Potter, Moyer, Schoonmaker, Waldron and Berg; nays: none. Alderman Potter moved to table the April 14, 2020 Committee-of-the-Whole Minutes. Seconded by Alderman Williams. Motion passed on roll call with the following vote: ayes: Aldermen Williams, Parker, Wendt, Potter, Moyer, Schoonmaker, Waldron and Berg; nays: none.

**Resolutions**

**5. Council Bill/Resolution 1055-2020**

**A Resolution authorizing the cancellation of the invitation for bids for Project #1338, 2020 Sidewalk Program, which results were publicly opened and read on April 14, 2020, in accordance with Section 27-3102 of the Moline Code of Ordinances.**

**Approved:** Alderman Parker, seconded by Alderman Moyer, moved to approve Council Bill 1055-2020. Motion carried on roll call with the following vote: ayes: Aldermen Williams, Parker, Wendt, Potter, Moyer, Schoonmaker, Waldron and Berg; nays: none.

**6. Council Bill/Resolution 1056-2020**

**A Resolution authorizing the Mayor and City Clerk to execute and attest to a contract with Walter D. Laud, Inc. for Project #1335, 19<sup>th</sup> Avenue Reconstruction, 13<sup>th</sup> Street to 14<sup>th</sup> Street, in the amount of \$693,277.53.**

**Approved:** Alderman Parker, seconded by Alderman Moyer, moved to approve Council Bill 1056-2020. There was discussion. Motion carried on roll call with the following vote: ayes: Aldermen Williams, Parker, Wendt, Potter, Schoonmaker, Waldron and Berg; nays: Aldermen Moyer and Potter.

**Council, Staff and Citizen Comments:**

Members of Council wished Mayor Acri a happy birthday.

Alderman Potter suggested that the Council review an April 13<sup>th</sup> email from Interim City Administrator J.D. Schulte for pertinent information regarding CIP funding.

Alderman Moyer noted that the City was founded on this day in 1848

Alderman Waldron asked that requests for water/sewer bill relief and non-shut-off be reviewed on a case-by-case basis in consideration of complaints from landlords.

Mayor Acri explained that some organizations and businesses have requested direct financial support from the City and she requested Council's input. There was support for waiving downtown parking leases during the COVID-19 stay-at-home mandate. Corporation Counsel Derke Price recommended that spaces received as development agreement incentive should still pay. Mayor Acri suggested deferring without penalty. Staff will follow up on the requests to obtain more information.

Mayor Acri explained that a virtual State of the City event will take place on May 11<sup>th</sup> at noon.

Mayor Acri shared that Moline's twin town, Asbach, Germany, has been impacted by COVID-19 as well.

Mayor Acri shared additional public comments emailed from Dee Canfield, 2401 12<sup>th</sup> Avenue; Jim, Audrey and Grant Adamson, 2610 15<sup>th</sup> Avenue; Shawn Roselieb, Executive Director Illinois Fraternal Order of Police Labor Council; Karrah Kuykendall

**Executive Session:**

Alderman Williams, seconded by Alderman Potter, moved for Executive Session, for the purpose of discussion of Collective Negotiating Matters-5 ILCS 120/2 (C)(2). Motion carried on roll call with the following vote: ayes: Aldermen Williams, Parker, Wendt, Potter, Moyer, Schoonmaker, Waldron and Berg; nays: none.


City Council convened in Executive Session at 8:36 p.m.
