MOLINE CITY COUNCIL MEETING

City Hall, 619 16th Street
Tuesday, September 22, 2020

Council Meeting: The City Council meeting came to order at 6:49 p.m. The Council met in regular session in the Council Chambers at City Hall.

Pledge: The Council and audience recited the Pledge of Allegiance.

Invocation: There was no Invocation.

Roll Call: Roll call was taken with Mayor Acri, Aldermen Williams, Parker, Wendt, Potter, Moyer, Schoonmaker, Waldron and Berg present. Absent: None.

Second Reading Ordinances

1. Council Bill/General Ordinance 3027-2020

An Ordinance amending Chapter 20, "MOTOR VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC," of the Moline Code of Ordinances, Appendix 3 thereof, "PEDESTRIAN CROSSING SIGNALS," by repealing "Midblock on Sixteenth Street between Twenty-fifth and Twenty-sixth Avenues."

Resolutions

2. Council Bill/Resolution 1099-2020

A Resolution authorizing the Mayor and City Clerk to approve and attest to an exception to the moratorium on hiring pursuant to Resolution 1051-2020 to hire two police officers in November to fill current vacancies and an additional three officers in January to fill upcoming vacancies.

Omnibus Vote: Alderman Parker, seconded by Alderman Wendt, moved to approve and adopt, by omnibus vote, these items. Motion carried on roll call with the following vote: ayes: Aldermen Potter, Moyer, Schoonmaker, Waldron, Berg Williams, Parker and Wendt; nays: none.

First Reading Ordinances

3. Council Bill/General Ordinance 3023-2020

An Ordinance Amending Chapter 19, "MOBILE HOMES AND MOBILE HOME PARKS," of the Moline Code of Ordinances, to modify the regulations for mobile homes in the City.

4. Council Bill/General Ordinance 3028-2020

An Ordinance amending Chapter 20, "MOTOR VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC," of the Moline Code of Ordinances, Appendix 7 thereof, "ONE-WAY STREETS," by including Thirty-Second Avenue, from Fourth Street to Seventh Street, traveling westbound for the hours of 7:30 a.m. to 8:30 a.m. and 1:00 p.m. to 3:30 p.m. on school days.

5. Council Bill/General Ordinance 3029-2020

An Ordinance amending Chapter 20, "MOTOR VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC," of the Moline Code of Ordinances, Section 20-2202, "LOADING ZONES," by including Twelfth Avenue, from Forty-First Street to Forty-Eighth Street, for the hours of 7:30 a.m. to 8:30 a.m. and 1:00 p.m. to 3:30 p.m. on school days.

Council, Staff and Citizen Comments:

At Alderman Parker's inquiry, Public Works Director J.D. Schulte indicated that engineering and grant identification for resurfacing work on 19th Avenue between 1st Street and 16th Street had not yet begun.

Mayor Acri requested input in response to citizen inquiries: 1) Rental/Landlord complaints should be directed to Brad Hauman, Neighborhood Improvement Officer, and K.J. Whitley, Community Development Program Manager; and 2) Requests for permit-only parking should be submitted as a formal request to the Traffic Committee.

Mayor Acri indicated that the new I-74 bridge, westbound, will be open by year-end.

Executive Session:

Alderman Williams, seconded by Alderman Parker, moved for Executive Session, for the purpose of discussion of Collective Negotiating Matters-5 ILCS 120/2(C)(2), Appointment, Employment, Compensation, Discipline, Performance, or Dismissal of Specific Employees-5 ILCS 120/2(C)(1). Motion carried on roll call with the following vote: ayes: Aldermen Potter, Moyer, Schoonmaker, Waldron, Berg, Williams, Parker, Wendt; nays: none.

City Council convened in Executive Session at 6:58 p.m.

Council reconvened in open session at 7:25 p.m.

On motion of Alderman Potter, seconded by Alderman Williams, Council adjourned at 7:25 p.m.
