MOLINE CITY COUNCIL MEETING

City Hall, 619 16th Street
Tuesday, November 17, 2020

Council Meeting: The City Council meeting came to order at 8:59 p.m. The Council met in regular session in the Council Chambers at City Hall.

Pledge: The Council and audience recited the Pledge of Allegiance.

Invocation: There was no Invocation.

Roll Call: Roll call was taken with Mayor Acri, Aldermen Williams, Parker, Wendt, Potter, Moyer, Schoonmaker, Waldron and Berg present. Absent: None.

Second Reading Ordinances

1. Council Bill/General Ordinance 3033-2020

An Ordinance amending Chapter 8, "BUILDINGS AND OTHER CONSTRUCTION AND BUILDING SERVICES," of the Moline Code of Ordinances, Section 8-7500, "CRIME FREE RESIDENTIAL RENTAL PROGRAM," subparagraph (a).

2. Council Bill/General Ordinance 3034-2020

An Ordinance amending Chapter 4, "ALCOHOLIC LIQUOR," of the Moline Code of Ordinances, Section 4-4110, "SALES OF SINGLE SERVINGS OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES," and Sections 4-3302, 4-3303, 4-3304, 4-3305, 4-3306, 4-3307, 4-3309, 4-3310, 4-3315 concerning the sale of package goods, and deleting Section 4-3208, "LICENSE FEES," subparagraph (g) in its entirety.

A Resolution authorizing the Chief of Police, on behalf of the City of Moline, to execute the Multijurisdictional Law Enforcement Agreement between local law enforcement agencies.

5. Council Bill/Resolution 1123-2020

A Resolution authorizing approval of Change Order #1 and final with Walter D. Laud, Inc. for Project #1335, 19th Avenue Reconstruction, for the amount of \$34,783.43.

6. Council Bill/Resolution 1124-2020

A Resolution amending the Collaboration Agreement between the City of Moline and the Center for Youth and Family Services ("CYFS") to increase the minimum liability insurance coverage limits as indicated in Exhibit

A, attached hereto; and authorizing the Mayor and City Clerk to execute and attest to the amended Collaboration Agreement between the City of Moline and the Center for Youth and Family Services (“CYFS”). Alderman Parker, seconded by Alderman Moyer, moved to approve Council Bill 1124-2020. Motion carried on roll call with the following vote: ayes: Aldermen Parker, Wendt, Potter, Moyer, Schoonmaker, Waldron, Berg and Williams; nays: none.

First Reading Ordinances

7. Council Bill/General Ordinance 3035-2020

An Ordinance amending Chapter 35, “ZONING AND LAND DEVELOPMENT,” of the Moline Code of Ordinances, by repealing Tables 35-3201.3 and 35-3301.2 in their entirety and enacting in lieu thereof two new Tables 35-3201.3 and 35-3301.2 relating to the same subject matter.

8. Council Bill/General Ordinance 3036-2020

An Ordinance amending Chapter 35, “ZONING AND LAND DEVELOPMENT,” of the Moline Code of Ordinances, by amending Section 35-5209, concerning fences.

9. Council Bill/General Ordinance 3037-2020

An Ordinance amending Chapter 35, “ZONING AND LAND DEVELOPMENT,” of the Moline Code of Ordinances, Table 35-3401.1, “PERMITTED LAND USES,” by removing “Storage, Personal” as a permitted use in the “B-4” (Highway/Intensive Business) District.

10. Council Bill/General Ordinance 3038-2020

An Ordinance amending Chapter 24, “PERSONNEL,” of the Moline Code of Ordinances, Section 24-2305, concerning layoffs.

Council, Staff and Citizen Comments:

The Council wished everyone a Happy Thanksgiving, expressing appreciation for the hard work of Geoff Manis, Moline Centre Main Street Manager, in facilitating CURES procurement for bars and restaurants impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic; to Carol Barnes, Finance Director, and staff for their work to balance the City’s budget during this difficult year; and to Brian Lear, Library Director, Library Board and Library Staff for the wonderful work that they are doing.


Mayor Acri shared that Governor Pritzker announced a state-wide move to Tier 3 mitigation, beginning Friday at 12 a.m. She stated that all those that can telework should and recommended closing City Hall. There was discussion. Alderman Moyer made a motion to resume payment modifications in place at the beginning of the COVID-19 pandemic. Seconded by Alderman Berg. Motion passed on roll call with the following vote: ayes: Aldermen Parker, Wendt, Potter, Moyer, Schoonmaker, Waldron, Berg and Williams; nays: none.

Alderman Berg made a motion to close City Hall for two weeks, with the caveat that the City Clerk’s office will continue to process election filings during this time. Seconded by Alderman Moyer. There was discussion. Motion passed on roll call with the following vote: ayes: Aldermen Parker, Wendt, Potter, Moyer, Schoonmaker, Waldron, Berg and Williams; nays: none.

Mayor Acri adjourned the regular Council meeting at 9:26 p.m.
