MOLINE CITY COUNCIL MEETING

Tuesday, April 20, 2021

Council Meeting: The City Council meeting came to order at 7:16 p.m. The Council met in regular session in the Council Chambers at City Hall.

Pledge: The Council and audience recited the Pledge of Allegiance.

Invocation: There was no Invocation.

Roll Call: Roll call was taken with Mayor Acri, Aldermen Williams, Parker, Potter, Moyer, Schoonmaker, Waldron and Berg present. Absent: Alderman Wendt

Second Reading Ordinances

1. Council Bill/General Ordinance 3007-2021

An Ordinance amending Chapter 4, "ALCOHOLIC LIQUOR," of the Moline Code of Ordinances, Section 4-3208, "LICENSE FEES."

2. Council Bill/General Ordinance 3008-2021

An Ordinance amending Chapter 3, "ADVERTISING AND SIGNS," Sections 3-1103 and 3-1104; and Chapter 20, "MOTOR VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC," Section 20-6109, of the Moline Code of Ordinances, regarding pedestrian and vehicular traffic.

3. Council Bill/Resolution 1098-2021

A Resolution authorizing the Mayor and City Clerk to execute and attest to a contract with Five Cities Construction Company for Project #1352, 2021 Sidewalk Program, for an amount of \$254,975.

Omnibus Vote: Alderman Parker, seconded by Alderman Waldron, moved to approve and adopt, by omnibus vote, these items. Motion carried on roll call with the following vote: ayes: Aldermen Potter, Moyer, Schoonmaker, Waldron, Berg, Williams and Parker; nays: none.

Resolutions

4. Council Bill/Resolution 1099-2021

A Resolution authorizing the Mayor and City Clerk to execute and attest to an Intergovernmental Agreement between the City of Moline and the City of Silvis, setting forth the terms for animal control services.

Approved. Alderman Parker, seconded by Alderman Waldron, moved to approve Council Bill 1099-2021. Motion carried on roll call with the following vote: ayes: Aldermen Potter, Moyer, Schoonmaker, Waldron, Berg, Williams and Parker; nays: none.

5. Council Bill/Resolution 1100-2021

A Resolution declaring leftover American Flags (stick-flag size) from the Census Committee to be surplus property and authorizing the Mayor to donate them to the Optimist Club.

Approved. Alderman Parker, seconded by Alderman Berg, moved to approve Council Bill 1100-2021. Motion carried on roll call with the following vote: ayes: Aldermen Potter, Moyer, Schoonmaker, Waldron, Berg, Williams and Parker; nays: none.

6. Council Bill/Resolution 1101-2021

A Resolution authorizing the Mayor and City Clerk to execute and attest to Stipulated Agreement 2131 with the Illinois Commerce Commission concerning improvements to the 34th Street Rail Crossing and approaches.

Approved. Alderman Parker, seconded by Alderman Waldron, moved to approve Council Bill 1101-2021. Motion carried on roll call with the following vote: ayes: Aldermen Potter, Moyer, Schoonmaker, Waldron, Berg, Williams and Parker; nays: none.

7. Council Bill/Resolution 1102-2021

A Resolution authorizing the Mayor and City Clerk to execute and attest to a Real Estate Purchase Agreement for the purchase of 3218 – 41st Street, Moline, Illinois, with the use of Library Funds.

Approved. Alderman Parker, seconded by Alderman Waldron, moved to approve Council Bill 1102-2021. Motion carried on roll call with the following vote: ayes: Aldermen Potter, Moyer, Schoonmaker, Waldron, Berg and Williams; nays: Alderman Parker.

8. Council Bill/Resolution 1103-2021

A Resolution authorizing the City Administrator to modify the non-union employee group benefit package to incorporate the changes as set forth in Exhibit A, attached hereto, relating to wages and health insurance premiums.

Approved. Alderman Parker, seconded by Alderman Waldron, moved to approve Council Bill 1103-2021. Motion carried on roll call with the following vote: ayes: Aldermen Potter, Moyer, Schoonmaker, Waldron, Berg, Williams and Parker; nays: none.

First Reading Ordinances**9. Council Bill/General Ordinance 3009-2021**

An Ordinance amending Chapter 21, “NUISANCES IN GENERAL,” Section 21-3101, “Definitions,” of the Moline Code of Ordinances.

Council, Staff and Citizen Comments:

The Mayor and Aldermen expressed appreciation for the contributions, sacrifices and successes of this Council and specifically of its outgoing members. Each was presented with a Proclamation and Recognition of Service.

Other – Outdoor Dining. Alderman Waldron, seconded by Alderman Parker, moved to direct staff to repeat what was done in 2020 to support restaurants create outdoor dining areas. Geoff Manis, Moline Centre Main Street Manager, explained that, at a joint meeting tomorrow, the Special Service Area Boards will consider the purchase of bike racks to be used to assist restaurants in creating outdoor dining areas. Motion passed on roll call with the following vote: ayes: Aldermen Wendt, Potter, Moyer, Schoonmaker, Waldron, Berg, Williams and Parker; nays: none
