AN ORDINANCE

AMENDING Chapter 11, "FIRE PREVENTION AND PROTECTION," of the Moline Code of Ordinances, by amending Section 11-1101 (f) 107.2.1, "TEST AND INSPECTION RECORDS."

WHEREAS, the City of Moline is a home rule unit of government and has the authority to adopt ordinances, to promulgate rules and regulations that pertain to its government and affairs, including the permitting and regulation of structures and the regulation of life safety systems to protect the public health, safety, and welfare of its residents; and

WHEREAS, in Chapter 11, "FIRE PREVENTION AND PROTECTION," of the Moline Code of Ordinances, the City has adopted ordinances and promulgated rules and regulations concerning fire protection and prevention; and

WHEREAS, in the exercise of its home rule powers, the City desires to amend its Code of Ordinances concerning maintenance obligations for fire protection and life safety systems.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MOLINE, ILLINOIS, as follows:

**Section 1** – That the facts and statements contained in the preambles to this ordinance are found to be true and correct and are hereby adopted as part of this ordinance.

**Section 2** – That Chapter 11, "FIRE PREVENTION AND PROTECTION" section 11-1101 (F) 107.2.1, "TEST AND INSPECTION RECORDS," is amended as follows (additions marked by underline; deletions marked by ~~striketrough~~):

**107.2.1 Test and inspection records.** Required test and inspection records for Fire Protection and Life Safety Systems shall be maintained by the system owner and made available to the fire code official at all times and the system owner and/or any contractor performing inspection, testing and/or maintenance services shall file the inspection records for all Fire Protection and Life Safety Systems ~~fire sprinkler systems, commercial kitchen extinguishing systems, and fire alarm systems shall be filed~~ with the fire code official in an approved digital format within a reasonable time after the inspection is performed, not to exceed forty-five (45) days. For purposes of this Chapter, "Fire Protection and Life Safety Systems" shall have the same meaning as given by the National Fire Protection Association.

**Section 3** – That if any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed a separate, distinct, and independent provision and such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions hereof.

**Section 4** – That all prior ordinances and resolutions in conflict or inconsistent herewith are hereby expressly repealed only to the extent of such conflict or inconsistency.

**Section 5** – That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after passage, approval, and if required by law, publication in the manner provided for by law.


