JOB CHARACTERISTICS: Under general supervision, performs technical work in drafting, surveying, data collection, material testing or construction observation on municipal public works projects. Work is of average difficulty requiring the development of independent work sequences within established procedures, methods and policies. Performs other duties as assigned.

REQUIRES: High school diploma or GED equivalent with an understanding of algebra and trigonometry; valid Illinois driver’s license or equivalent; or any equivalent combination of training and experience which provides the required knowledge, skills and abilities. Compliance with City Residency Policy within prescribed time period required. The current Residency Policy states that AFSCME employees shall live within a 20-mile radius from the City’s Emergency Center, located at 1630 8th Avenue in Moline, within 180 days of hire.

Must possess broad knowledge of the terminology, methods, practices and techniques of engineering drafting, surveying and construction; knowledge of mathematics to include algebra and trigonometry; knowledge of the use and care of drafting and testing equipment, surveying instruments, measuring devices and hand tools.

Skill in the use of total station surveying equipment, auto cad drafting and material testing equipment; skill in the interpretation of technical drawing and contract documents; and skill in use of a motor vehicle.

Ability to interpret and apply engineering data; ability to interpret engineering drawings, specifications and details; ability to understand technical data presented in either oral or written form; ability to establish and maintain effective working relationships with other employees, officials and the general public; and ability to perform physical activities frequently at a medium demand level.
