

Make an Origami Water Cup

Every time you take a drink of water you should stop and think where that water came from. Moline's water comes from the Mississippi River and everything you do affects what that water quality is like. Do what you can to keep that water clean!

Here's a craft project for you to keep that clean water in while you hydrate yourself and stay healthy. All you need is a square piece of paper!

1. Fold the square in half to form a triangle.
2. Fold right-hand point of triangle over the left (point A to point C)
3. Fold point B to the left to point D.
4. Take pointed end of paper (E) and fold one piece down over the two flaps and you just created in steps 2 & 3.
5. Take the other pointed end and fold it the opposite way to form a flat line across the open end of the cup.
6. With fingers on points A and B, pinch slightly to open cup.

For a longer lasting cup, use heavy waxed paper.
